3. The essay must be original and submitted in either typed or printed form.
4. The closing date for the competition is **28 February 2010**.
5. A hard copy of your essay must be submitted together with this entry form. Incomplete entries and entries received after the closing date will not be entertained.
6. None of your personal particulars should be written on your essay.
7. The decision of the panel of judges is final.
8. All essays submitted will automatically become the property of the Malaysian Bar and may not be printed, published, or amended, without the prior permission of the Malaysian Bar.
9. The organiser reserves the right to call off or postpone the competition without prior notice.
